## On behalf of the three existing networks.

Due to the urgency of endorsing the grant document the process relating to the establishment of the new network has been somewhat hasty. In view of the short notices given for the call for the First General Meeting and development of a proposal for member composition of the board, the new board is encouraged to call an Extraordinary General Meeting no later than half a year after the First General Meeting. The agenda of the Extraordinary General Meeting should include fresh election of all board members – this in order to ensure a more democratic election process.
